#### **Application**

Applicants to CEAD credit courses should be age 21 before January of the year study starts. Applicants should have previously completed a foundational credit or non-credit art, design or photography programme such as one of NCAD's summer or autumn short courses.

### **Progression**

Students can progress from non-credit courses to one of the University Certificate programmes such as JOD (plus 2 VAP mandatory modules), DVI, PDI or VAP. On completing 30 credits, students are eligible to apply to the Higher Diploma in Art.

### **BA Degree**

On successful completion of the Higher Diploma in Art, students will have accrued 90 credits and be eligible to apply for Advanced Entry up to the final year of the NCAD full-time undergraduate BA in Fine Art.
