Portfolio Brief 2024

Students should complete Part 1 and Part 2

Part 1: Environment/Landscape DESCRIPTION

Define a particular geographical location and produce a series of photographs within a 200-metre radius of the chosen location. The completed images should work as a series and communicate a **specific point of view about the area**. The project may be undertaken with either analogue or digital technology.

Students should demonstrate how to:

- Operate a 35mm camera
- Competency in the use of aperture, depth of field and focal length
- Produce a workbook

Submission Requirements

- A series of 8 to 12 finished images communicating the brief
- Workbook including contact sheets and any research undertaken showing development of exercise

Part 2: Other Images

8 to 12 images from your own portfolio showing a variety of your own work.

Criteria for Selection

Is based on your portfolio and application form. Please make sure you have demonstrated

- Technical skill and knowledge in photography
- Presented evidence of idea development through the use of a notebook or workbook
- Technical knowledge and skill of basic techniques of analogue and digital photography
- Capability to bring a project to completion
- Completed an introductory photography course with CEAD or another provider
- Are 21 years of age at time of entry to course
- Have completed Leaving Certificate or Level 5 FETAC equivalent
- Have English proficiency
