



1916 'Leaders and Learners' Bursaries Terms and Conditions 2018-19

- The 1916 'Leaders and Learners' Bursaries are tenable for the duration of the primary degree programme undertaken. If a student has to repeat a stage the bursary will be suspended for that year and will resume once the student progresses. Academic performance will be monitored and support provided if necessary
- A student can only hold one bursary. In the event of a student qualifying for more than one scholarship, the scholarship of the greatest value will be awarded
- Scholars will be paid their bursary in 2 instalments each year by electronic transfer
- Awarding of this bursary will not affect entitlement to the Student Grant administered SUSI
- Students who are awarded a bursary are required to pay any fees due to their Higher Education Institution. Failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of the bursary
- The bursary cannot be deferred
- Successful candidates will be required to provide a short report and photographs, extracts of which may be used in publicity materials
- The bursary may be withdrawn should a student continually fail to complete the academic standards of their programme, or if they face disciplinary proceedings within their institution
- 1916 'Learners and Leaders' Scholars will be encouraged to act as role models and participate in mentoring/leadership programmes within their institution and their local community. The bursary award may be reviewed should disciplinary issues arise.
