WHAT: the Archie Bray Foundation for the Ceramic Arts is a public, non-profit, educational institution founded in 1951 by brick maker Archie Bray. Its primary mission is to provide an environment that stimulates creative work in ceramics. Long-term fellows are expected to embrace the Bray experience of community and creative exchange, and have the opportunity to focus their attention to produce and exhibit a significant body of work during their residency. Although the fellowships are non-renewable, the artists may elect to extend their residency for up to a second year.
