WHAT: residencies at Fireworks Clay Studio for recent graduates specialising in ceramics. The scheme aims to support two newly graduated ceramic artists through their first year of professional practice by offering a fully furnished studio space at a heavily subsidised cost with full use of all studio equipment for a period of one year. The successful applicants will be able to take full advantage of working alongside full time professional members and gain vital exposure to gallery representatives and enthusiasts.

WHAT: the Archie Bray Foundation for the Ceramic Arts is a public, non-profit, educational institution founded in 1951 by brick maker Archie Bray. Its primary mission is to provide an environment that stimulates creative work in ceramics. Long-term fellows are expected to embrace the Bray experience of community and creative exchange, and have the opportunity to focus their attention to produce and exhibit a significant body of work during their residency. Although the fellowships are non-renewable, the artists may elect to extend their residency for up to a second year.
