- This is an example of a general keyword search ("Collage").
- Note the **filters** on the left hand side of the screen: '*Print Books*' & '*Main Library*' only.
- Use these to focus your search & to reduce the range of results (from 1,500 to 333).

Tip: Including additional relevant keywords will yield fewer, more specific results

This is a sample search result:



- Check the format ('*Print Book*') & whether the book is 'Available' or 'On Loan'.
- Make a note of the 'Call Number' (e.g. '751.493 KRY').
- Note: You will need this number to locate the book in the library (every book has a Call Number label on its spine).
- The sequence of library books is organised using these numbers (first numerically, then alphabetically).
- The library collection is also arranged by subject areas; i.e. similar titles will be shelved together.

Tips: The letters at the end of the Call Number are an abbreviation of the author surname. Try browsing next to your book on the shelf for similar items that also may be useful.

e-Books



- This time we use the **eBook** filter so that only online resources are displayed in the search result.
- Click on '*View eBook*' you will be prompted to log in with your student credentials.

Tip: you can usually download around 1-2 chapters of an online book only due to copyright restrictions.

03 - Journal Articles

Journals are resources that publish academic **articles**. A typical academic article will be between 3,000 - 10,000 words. Most contemporary journals are hosted online in collections called **databases**.

You will be prompted to log in with your student credentials when accessing these online resources.



- When searching for an article in the catalogue, use the 'Article' filter to see relevant results.
- The number of available results is noted in brackets.

- This is a list of the databases available to you.
- When you use the catalogue, all of these databases will be included in your search by default.
- You can refine your search by selecting / deselecting any of these within the **Advanced Search** settings.
- Note the descriptions for each collection this will help you decide which collections are most relevant for you.

Print Journals

- The EML subscribes to a wide range of print journals; the most recent copies can be found on shelves opposite the **Issue Desk**. These are regularly updated, and back issues are also available on request.
- Readers can borrow two journals for a period of four weeks, with the option to renew for one week.



Digital Magazines
