As part of the preparation for a professional career in education and for the continuation of their professional development throughout that career as a lifelong learner, each student is required to commence the compilation of their Professional Portfolio. This will contain a range of material reflecting their personal and professional experience while on the PME programme. The portfolio will be constructed in mixed media – including, for example, visual record of work done by the student-teacher and by his/her pupils, written documentation, and samples of various material and resources encountered.

A digital base for the portfolio will normally be expected

- Identify significant items of evidence to support their reflection on a range of different learning experiences
- Utilise digital media for the storing, recording and processing of material for the portfolio
- Demonstrate their professional and learning profile though the evidence of a portfolio that is organic and flexible
