This module is designed to introduce participants to entrepreneurial thinking and action generally, and the creation of new ventures specifically. Learning will be relevant to starting new commercial ventures, new social ventures and new lines of business in existing companies (intrapreneurship).

The module will cover major theoretical and conceptual issues in the entrepreneurship research literature and show how they apply in a variety of contexts. Participants will generate their own new business ideas, develop them collaboratively, and undertake the initial phases of bringing them to market.

### What will I learn?

On successful completion of this module students will be able to:

- Outline major theories and concepts from the entrepreneurship literature and relate them to practical applications in a variety of settings
- Identify and demonstrate the characteristics of successful entrepreneurs
- Demonstrate diagnostic skills and a conceptual framework for new venture creation problem solving
- Forge ideas into workable business concepts and test them in the marketplace
- Develop tested concepts into business plans that can attract the resources needed for market entry
