Semester 1 & 2

The aim of this module is to give students an opportunity to undertake a research project written in continuous prose and present a statement of practice. Building on work over the previous two years, students will demonstrate a clear critical understanding of key historical and theoretical writing, research practices and methods that inform both their research project and their chosen studio discipline. Students choose their own area to research, within Visual Culture parameters, and are allocated a tutor appropriate to the topic to supervise their research project in semester 1. In semester 2 students write and present a short statement of practice which provides a critical explanation of their current studio work.

What will I learn?

On successful completion of this module students should be able to:

- 1. PLAN: Undertake self-directed research using appropriate time management skills, including tutorial attendance, participation and timely draft submission.
- 2. RESEARCH: Evidence a critical understanding of the key theories, practices and methods that inform the research project and employ an appropriate range of research strategies and sources.
- 3. ANALYSE: Synthesise and reflect critically on the results of research and practice.
- **4.** COMMUNICATE: Demonstrate your ability to manage, structure and resolve an extended essay and a statement of practice presented in an appropriate and coherent form.
