

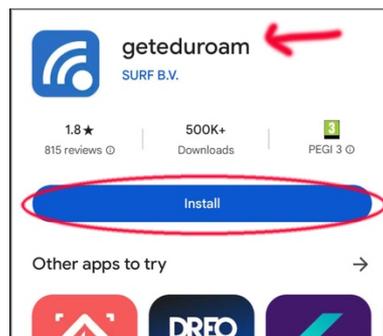
Eduroam on an Android Device

Note: you must be connected to a data or wireless network to do these steps

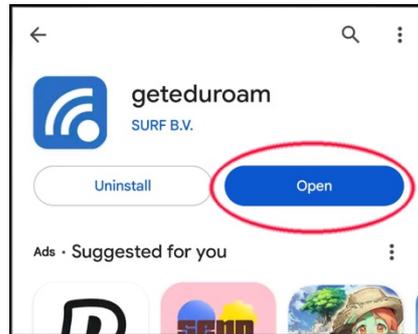
- 1) If you have an existing NCAD “eduroam” profile installed please remove it first. i.e. select System Settings/ Settings, under Wireless and Networks select Wi-Fi/ Wi-Fi Settings, long press **eduroam** network, tap forget Network
- 2) Go to Play Store



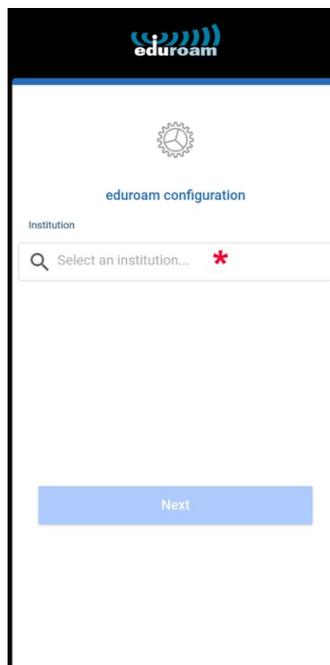
- 3) If the mobile device runs Android 8 or later, search for the **geteduroam** app and click Install



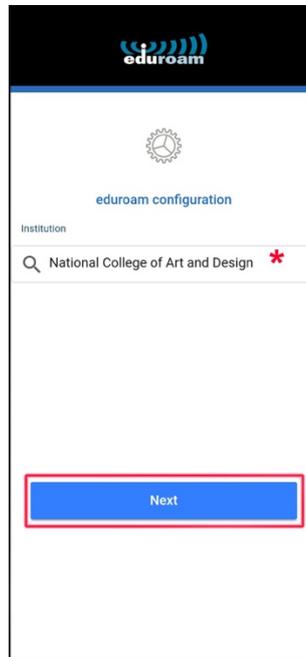
4) Once installed click Open



5) Once opened search for National College of Art & Design



6) Select National College of Art & Design and click Next



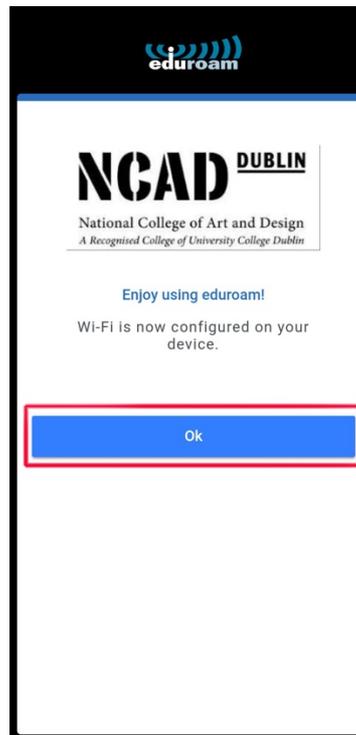
