

# **Audio Visual Instructions**

## Step 1: Connect cables


- A. (hdmi to projector) and
- B. ( usb b/a for camera at back of room and microphones in ceiling)

to your laptop.



#### Step 2: From the Extron controller select the following.

Note if the screen is dark just touch it to wake it




- 1. Press "POWER ON" to power on the projector
- 2. Press "LAPTOP" to ensure your laptop is select as the input device
- 3. Press "PRESENTATION MODE" if presenting to the room and to someone on Zoom/Teams/Meet
- 4. Press "LT CONFERENCE MODE" (stands for Laptop Conference Mode) if people on the Zoom/Teams/Meet are presenting
- Press whatever mics you want on Note: For LT CONFERENCE MODE "Ceiling Mic" must be on for the remote parties to hear you. The podium mic does not work in LT CONFERENCE MODE
- 6. Press the Up/Down Arrows for raising and lowering the volume

When presenting in the room or remotely you will need to switch between PRESENTATION MODE and LT CONFERENCE MODE








#### Step 4: If using an Apple laptop please ensure the following

Speakers (Outputs): Set to HDMI


Video: Aver DL30
