We are looking for people with a degree in Product Design (or a related field) and a desire to use design to transform and transition towards a circular economy. The successful applicant will use design research to build a better understanding of the barriers to a circular economy and will propose new design solutions for potential product service systems related to effective resource management. The project will be based between the NCAD Product Design department and the Rediscovery Centre in Ballymun.

The Rediscovery Centre is the National Centre for the Circular Economy and is a creative movement connecting people, ideas and resources for greener living in Ireland. It brings together the skills and expertise of artists, scientists, designers and craftspeople united in a common purpose of sustainability.

The Eastern Midlands Waste Region (EMWR) is one of Ireland's three waste management regions which serves approximately half the national population, over 2.2 million people. They are focused on waste prevention, resource efficiency, innovation and the provision of technical expertise on waste infrastructure.

Applicants should apply to the NCAD MA Product Design programme and alongside required documentation include a statement outlining why they should be selected for the scholarship. Deadline: July 12th 2019.
